TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

We are so distracted with cell phones, laptops, tablets, televisions, empty discussions, laziness, money, possessions, houses, cars and the obsessed search for the perfect life without pain... but I believe we have hope because even some of the apostles were very distracted at that time and with Jesus himself beside them. Jesus was telling them that he was going to die on a cross and they were worried about who was first in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus wants to talk to us every day and He wants to tell us wonderful things that He has in His heart and He wants to do it through prayer, contemplation of a wonderful landscape, reading the Holy Scriptures, praying the liturgy of the hours, Eucharistic Adoration, etc. but we are so distracted that sometimes we don't have time to listen to Him. Just pay attention to what happens to you every day, even pay attention to the smallest details, possibly Jesus speaks to you through them. God loves you with infinite tenderness, Happy Sunday!

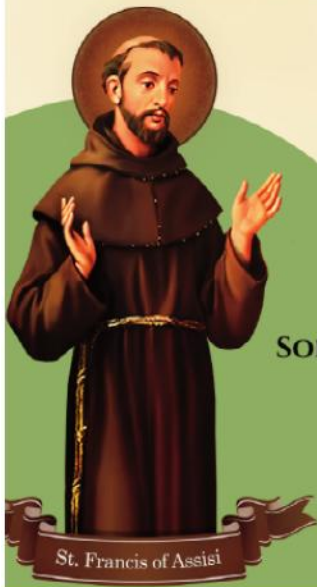

Who is St. Francis of Assisi?

St. Francis of Assisi was born in the 12th century, lived in Italy, and founded the men's Order of Friars Minor, the women's Order of St. Clare, and the Third Order of Saint Francis for men and women not able to live the lives of itinerant preachers. Francis is one of the most venerated religious figures in history.

He is remembered for his generosity to the poor, his willingness to minister to the lepers, and for his love for animals and nature. He is the Catholic Church's patron saint of animals and the environment.
