We are so distracted with cell phones, laptops, tablets, televisions, empty discussions, laziness, money, possessions, houses, cars and the obsessed search for the perfect life without pain... but I believe we have hope because even some of the apostles were very distracted at that time and with Jesus himself beside them. Jesus was telling them that he was going to die on a cross and they were worried about who was first in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus wants to talk to us every day and He wants to tell us wonderful things that He has in His heart and He wants to do it through prayer, contemplation of a wonderful landscape, reading the Holy Scriptures, praying the liturgy of the hours, Eucharistic Adoration, etc. .... but we are so distracted that sometimes we don't have time to listen to Him. Just pay attention to what happens to you every day, even pay attention to the smallest details, possibly Jesus speaks to you through them. God loves you with infinite tenderness, Happy Sunday!


