Dear Parishioners,

I am filled with great joy to share some wonderful news with you. Two young men from our Newman Fellowship at Trine University have discerned a call to the priesthood and are taking steps toward entering the seminary. This is a moment of deep gratitude and celebration for our parish, as these are the first vocations born from our own community. It is a beautiful sign of God's work among us and a blessing for the future of the Church. They are Eli Shoup and Aaron Reichert.

Eli Shoup is an engineering graduate from Trine this year. He spent four years living here in Angola, actively participating in student activities and serving as president of Newman. Eli has been accepted by his bishop and will be a diocesan seminarian for the Diocese of Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Aaron Reichert studied engineering for one year at Trine and served as vice president of Newman. He lived in Angola for a year and was a lector at Sunday Mass. Aaron continues in the discernment process, and all signs are very positive, as he has been encouraged to step away from the university. He is expected to be a diocesan seminarian for the Diocese of Toledo, Ohio.

We also extend our heartfelt gratitude to Fr. Jorge and Fr. Raul for their generous ministry, especially to Fr. Raul for accompanying and guiding these two young men in their vocational discernment.
