A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

We just celebrated the feast of all Saints and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed last week, and I think these feasts remind us of two important realities: all of us are invited to become saints and that should happen before we die. Some of us might say, "I am very weak, I am very sinner, that is not for me...". If I were having that conversation in spiritual direction with someone, I would tell him, "Welcome to the club, we were missing you. You are perfect for this vocation". St. Therese of Calcutta said once, "Holiness is not the luxury of the few; it is a simple duty, for you and for me, because Jesus has very clearly said, "Be ye holy as the father in heaven is holy.". Holiness is not about being perfect, it is the desire to be perfect and reach that with the grace of the LORD, it is He who makes us perfect. Of course, He needs our human will and our efforts to make the decision but if you open wide your heart to Him, He will do marvels in you. Time flies very fast, I wish we make this decision before we die, after that we don't have more opportunities. He makes us Saints here on Earth so that we can go to Heaven and to live with Him an eternal life in happiness. Take courage, He will not abandon you.

WHAT IS A BISHOP?

The diocesan Bishop is the chief teacher, sanctifier, and shepherd of God's people. Most Bishops are given a diocese to govern spiritually, making sure the priests, deacons, pastoral workers and catechists in their diocese are preaching the Gospel and teaching sound doctrine to the flock. He is the principal teacher. The Bishop is the primary dispenser of all the sacraments. He has oversight of the liturgy.

He possesses the fullness of Orders, so that the fullness of Christ's grace can flow through in sacramental form, to the sanctification of the faithful. Through his relationships with the priests of his diocese, the Bishop is able to shepherd the people of his diocese. The Bishops have been given a special outpouring of grace, to continue the work that the Apostles started.
