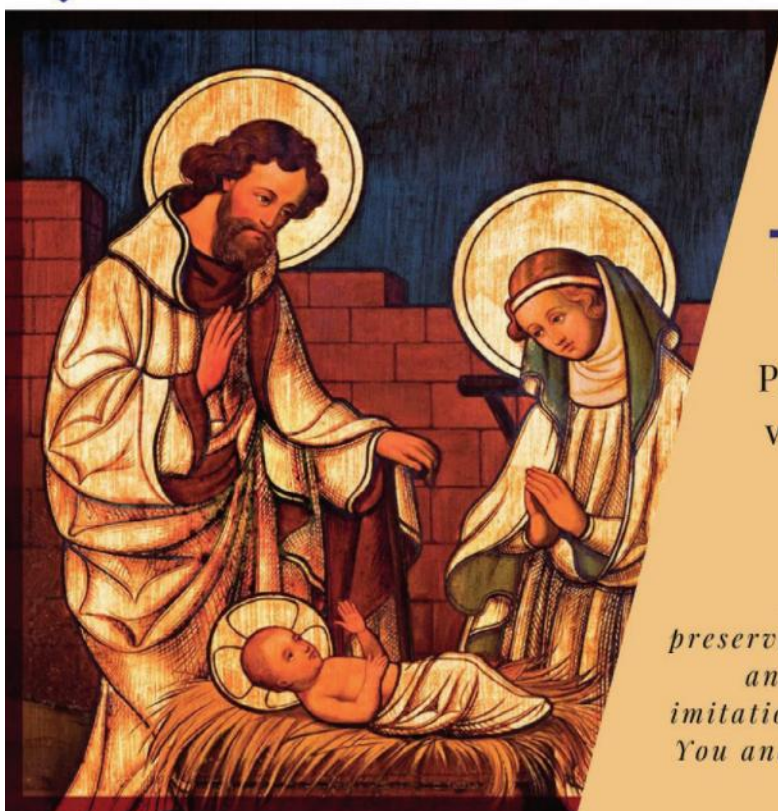

The Presentation of the Lord

Many times, we feel and we come to believe that we have nothing to offer others. We even often feel miserable because we think that we are not holy enough and that God deserves someone better than us. I remember that once in spiritual direction a person told me that he only had sins to offer Jesus and I remember that I replied, Perfect! Give them all to Him so that He may make them white as snow (cf. Isaiah 1:18). Pope Francis says Jesus is not afraid of our sin. It's not about sinning more; it's about surrendering to Him and recognizing that we need His help. You may not be able to offer Jesus a holy soul in immaculate like the Virgin's, but you can offer Him what you have because in what you have, He is going to show you His glory and His power. God loves you with great tenderness, Happy Sunday!

What is Candlemas?

Candlemas, Christian festival on February 2 commemorating the occasion when the Virgin Mary, in obedience to Jewish law, went to the Temple in Jerusalem both to be purified 40 days after the birth of her son, Jesus, and to present him to God as her firstborn (Luke 2:22-38). The festival was formerly known in the Roman Catholic Church as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is now known as the Presentation of the Lord.

By the middle of the 5th century the custom of observing the festival with lighted candles had been introduced, and the name Candlemas developed from this custom.
