SPIRITUAL DROP

XV Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 12, 2026

God knows each of His children very well and is fully aware of the capacity each of us has; that is why Jesus does not ask more of us than we can give. He knows that some can give 30%, others 20%, others 50%, and still others 100%. In the spiritual life, it is very important that we discover what God is asking us to give and what capacity we were created with, because we are not all the same. St. Thomas Aquinas had a different capacity than St. Carlo Acutis, but both are saints, and that is what really matters. Therefore, the challenge is to discover what God is calling us to do and to give the full percentage for which we were created. If you're a good cook and that's the only thing you know how to do, do it with love. If you speak 10 languages, don't boast about it—instead, put them to work for the common good. If you're a great scientist, put your knowledge to work for the good of others. The important thing is that you do it with love, because that is where your life will find meaning. If you were created to give 30%, you must give that 30%; it's not fair that you give only 10% or 20%. God will ask you for an account of what He has given you, not of what He has not given you.
God loves you with infinite tenderness.

Dios conoce muy bien a cada uno de sus hijos y sabe perfectamente la capacidad que cada uno de nosotros tiene, es por eso por lo que Jesús no nos pide más de lo que podemos dar. Sabe que unos pueden dar 30%, otros 20%, otros 50% y otros 100 %. En la vida espiritual es muy importante que descubramos que es lo que Dios nos pide que demos y para cuanta capacidad fuimos hechos porque no todos somos iguales. Santo Tomas de Aquino tenía una capacidad distinta a la de San Carlos Acutis, pero los dos son santos y esto es lo que en realidad importa. Por lo tanto, el reto es descubrir a qué nos llama Dios y dar todo el porcentaje para lo cual fuimos creado. Si sabes cocinar bien y es lo único que sabes hacer, hazlo con amor. Si sabes hablar 10 idiomas, no presumas de ello sino más bien ponlos al servicio del bien. Si eres un gran científico, pon tu conocimiento al servicio del del bien de los demás. Lo importante es que lo hagas con amor porque ahí tu vida encontrará sentido. Si fuiste creado para dar el 30% debes dar ese 30%, no es justo que solo des el 10% o el 20%. Dios te pedirá cuanta de lo que te ha dado, no de lo que no te ha dado. Dios te ama con ternura infinita.

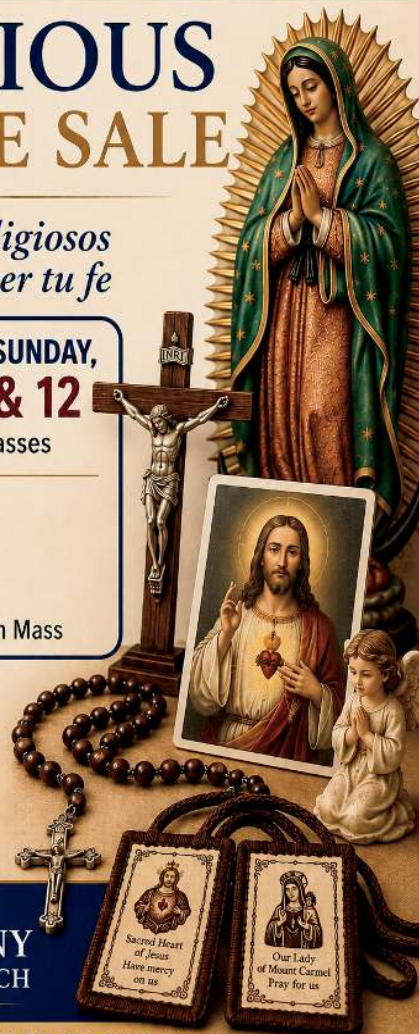
