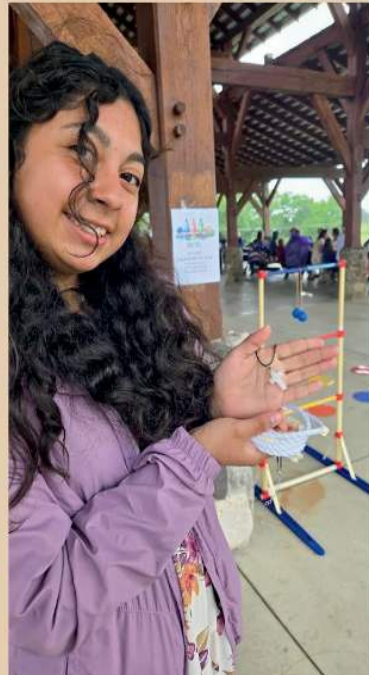

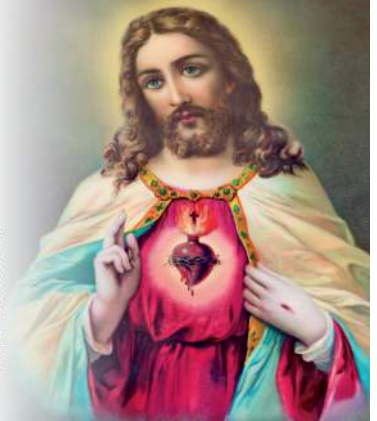

The Tootsie Roll Drive is a national fundraiser started in the early 1970's in the Chicago area by the Knights of Columbus to support organizations that help individuals with intellectual disabilities. Recognized by their bright yellow vests, Knights throughout the United States are present at banks, grocery stores and busy intersections accepting donations and thanking donors with a trademark Tootsie Roll.

Locally, since the late 70's, our Council #7053 Knights hold their Drive semi-annually in early June and early September collecting on an average of \$3,500 per season equally divided between these local recipients: Steuben County Special Olympics, Promise Land Community and Easterseals/Rise.

In our council's early years, knights would be collecting in the drive thru lanes of local banks, Scotts & Walmart & Meijer groceries, plus at our Monument Circle. Over the course of our 45+ years of helping the handicap, this ministry has had only three chairmen - Ken Hansen, Dan Stobierski and presently Jim Scott who recruit over 30 knights for each seasonal drive. Now our drives are held exclusively at Walmart plus at St. Anthony's & St. Paul's Chapel at the 4th of July weekend masses.

Thank you for your generous support over the last 45+ years in Steuben County to support our local disadvantaged individuals.
