SPIRITUAL DROP

XX Sunday in Ordinary Time – August 16, 2026

I remember that, on one occasion, I went to the supermarket with my parents. After we finished shopping, we were on our way out when, suddenly, my father and I lost sight of my mother. I started to get nervous because I couldn't find her. We went to the parking lot, and I told my dad to load the groceries into the car while I went back to look for her. As I made my way back toward the supermarket entrance, I finally found her. She was helping a very elderly woman in a wheelchair get into her car. The woman's husband, who was also elderly, was walking with crutches, and both of them were having a very hard time getting into the vehicle. My mother, without making a sound or drawing attention to herself, was there helping them with tenderness and calm. I ran over to her and told her I'd been looking for her. She calmly replied that she was helping that poor elderly woman and her husband get into the car. Then I asked her, "But how did you do that, if you don't speak English?" And she answered, "You don't need to speak English to help someone." In that moment, I saw a mother teaching the wisdom of life to a priest who, at times, thinks he knows a lot but who, in that moment, realized he knows very little. That afternoon I learned that there are no barriers to love. We often make up excuses to hide what we truly lack: love, the only universal language we'll speak in heaven. On the other hand, indifference and individualism are slowly killing us from the inside. That same afternoon, my mother told me that several people walked past those poor elderly people and didn't stop to help them.

Lord, grant us the grace to be witnesses of your love within the Church, in our homes, in the parks, and even in the supermarkets!
God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday!

Recuerdo que, en una ocasión, fui al supermercado con mis padres. Después de terminar las compras, íbamos saliendo cuando, de repente, mi padre y yo perdimos de vista a mi madre. Comencé a ponerme nervioso porque no la encontraba. Fuimos al estacionamiento y le dije a mi papá que acomodara las compras en el carro mientras yo regresaba a buscarla. Cuando me dirigía nuevamente hacia la entrada del supermercado, finalmente la encontré. Ella estaba ayudando a una señora muy anciana, que iba en silla de ruedas, a subir al coche. Su esposo, también anciano, caminaba con muletas, y a ambos se les hacía muy difícil entrar al vehículo. Mi madre, sin hacer ruido ni llamar la atención, estaba allí ayudándolos con ternura y calma. Corrí hacia ella y le dije que la había estado buscando. Ella me respondió con tranquilidad que estaba ayudando a aquella pobre anciana y a su esposo a subir al carro. Entonces le pregunté: "Pero ¿cómo hiciste, si no hablas inglés?". Y ella me contestó: "Para ayudar a alguien no es necesario hablar inglés". En ese momento vi a una madre enseñándole la sabiduría de la vida a un sacerdote que, a veces, cree saber mucho y que en ese momento se dio cuenta que sabe muy poquito. Aquella tarde aprendí que para el amor no existen barreras. Muchas veces inventamos excusas para ocultar lo que verdaderamente nos falta: amor, la única lengua universal que hablaremos en el cielo. Por otro lado, la indiferencia y el individualismo nos van matando por dentro. Esa misma tarde, mi madre me contó que varias personas pasaron junto a aquellos pobres ancianos y no se detuvieron a ayudarlos. ¡Señor, danos la gracia de ser testigos de tu amor dentro de la Iglesia, en nuestras casas, en los parques y hasta en los supermercados!
