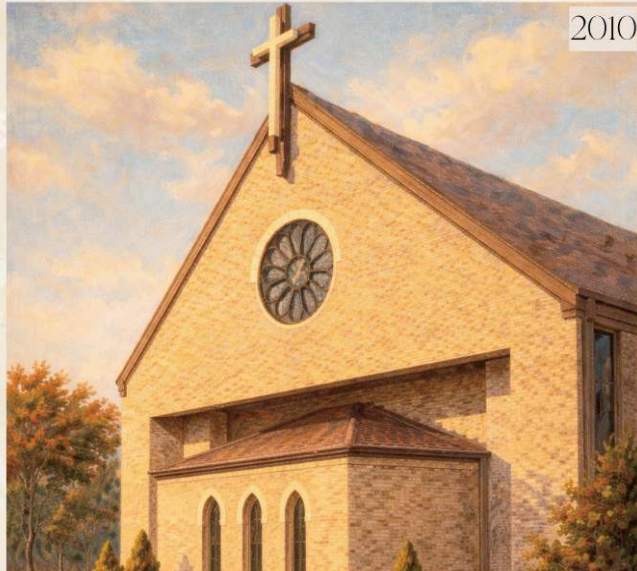

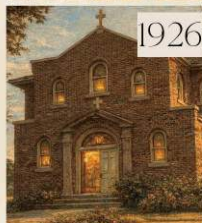

However, we know that we are in need of additional funds to complete the renovations and ensure that our offices are welcoming, functional, and able to meet the growing needs of our parish families.



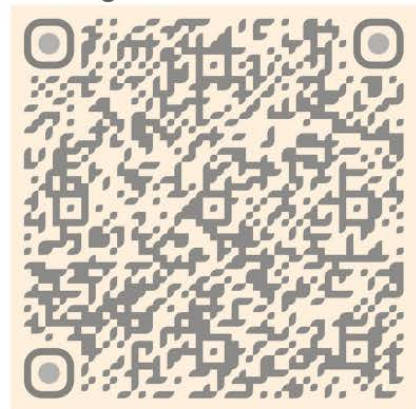
