A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

XXVI SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Many people suffer because they are not respected. They are good, but others take advantage of them. They are kind, yet many treat their kindness as weakness. On the other hand, those who are authoritarian often find themselves feared but unloved.

Why, then, did the Jews admire Jesus' authority so deeply? Because Jesus was not merely kind, nor was He authoritarian. He was a true man—full of truth. More than that, He is the Truth.

I firmly believe that the key to earning genuine respect is found in three "Be's":

Be of Christ, Be yourself, and Be truthful. The rest is extra...

Let us ask God that the true adornment of our personality may be authenticity—that we may be men and women of truth, grounded in goodness and sure of who we are in Christ.

Sé de Cristo, Sé tú mismo, Sé verdadero. Lo demás es añadidura... pidámosle a Dios que el adorno exquisito de nuestra personalidad sea ser hombres y mujeres verdaderos, llenos de Dios y seguros de lo que somos.





Fall Break


From October 12 through October 19, there will be a Fall Break. During this period, Religious Education classes will not meet.
