# The Diocesan Synod Comes to Our Parish

SYNOD 2026

Spreading the  
Fire of God's Love



The Diocese of Fort Wayne–South Bend has begun an important journey of prayer, listening, and discernment through a diocesan synod. A synod is a sacred process in which the Church comes together to **listen to the Holy Spirit and one another**, seeking guidance for the future mission of the Church in our diocese and local parish.

**Beginning the Journey:** The synod process will begin publicly in our parish this weekend and next, with introducing the synod and outlining what lies ahead. You'll notice banners, posters, and information shared in both eBulletins and printed bulletins around the parish. These are simply ways to spread the word and warmly invite everyone in our parish community to participate.

**Prayerful Opening and Parish Sign-Up:** The heart of the synod process begins with a **Prayerful Opening**, held over two weekends: **January 24–25 and January 31–February 1, 2026**.

During these weekends:

- 1) The **Synodal Prayer** will be added as the final prayer of the Prayers of the Faithful each week.
- 2) A brief overview of the synod and an explanation from our priests at the conclusion of Mass, and
- 3) All **parishioners who are confirmed** will be invited to sign up after Mass and receive a **Synod Reflection Booklet**, which will guide their prayer and reflection during the coming weeks.

**Five Weeks of Prayer and Reflection:** From **January 24–25 through February 28**, participants will be invited into a **five-week period of prayerful reflection with the Holy Spirit**. Each week will focus on a key synod topic: Evangelization, Catechesis, Spiritual and Liturgical Life, Vocations, and Social Outreach. Weekly reminders and reflections will encourage parishioners to pray with the Holy Spirit, reflect on their experiences, and record the insights that arise in preparation for sharing them with others.

**Consultation Day:** The prayer and reflection period will culminate in a parish **Consultation Day on Saturday, February 28, at St. Anthony Church (Angola)**. Parishioners who have participated in the reflection process will gather, guided by trained facilitators and notetakers. This day is dedicated to listening—respectfully and attentively—to the reflections and insights of fellow parishioners.

**From Parish to Diocese:** Following the Consultation Day a **Draft Summary** of parish insights will be completed by **March 13**. Our **Final Parish Synod Summary** will be completed and submitted to the diocesan office by **March 29**.

*Through prayer, reflection, and shared dialogue, the diocesan synod offers each parishioner of our parish a meaningful opportunity to help shape the future of our local churches and the Church in the Diocese of Fort Wayne–South Bend. All are encouraged to take part in this important moment of walking together in faith.*
