A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR Easter Sunday - Cycle A - April 5, 2026

Dear Friends in Christ,
Rejoice, for Christ is risen; He is truly risen!

This proclamation of joy does not stem from a vain, fleeting joy that brings happiness for just a moment in our lives. This greeting of joy comes from the firm faith that Christ is alive and loves us with infinite love, and this gives the soul firm hope, bringing it joy and enlightening it forever, making us aware that all the sorrows of this life are fleeting and that true life awaits us, as many of the Church Fathers used to say. I also love what Pope Leo XIV said a couple of weeks ago during the Angelus prayer in Rome: "Nothing created can quench our inner thirst, because we are made for God." Furthermore, let us remember that Jesus told us: "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Matthew 6:21). Definitely, only the Risen Christ can give meaning and shape to our lives. Perhaps the cause of stress and depression for many people is that they set their hearts on trivial and fleeting things, and that is why their hearts do not rest in peace and serenity. Let us not forget that we were created for something greater and more enduring, whose Rock of foundation is Christ himself. Could you say that you are fully happy and ready to die in peace, saying, "Mission accomplished"?
God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday!
