From the Pastor's Desk

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time - June 14, 2026

I am pleased to share with you that Jessica Jones has joined our parish staff as our new full-time Pastoral Assistant. In this important role, she will provide both pastoral and administrative support for St. Anthony's and St. Paul's. Jessica will help coordinate parish communication, events, ministries, liturgical and fundraising activities, while also assisting with office organization and the daily needs of the pastor. She will serve as a bridge between our parish communities, and will work closely with our staff, volunteers, and parish ministries to support the spiritual and pastoral mission of our parish with care, professionalism, and faithfulness to the Gospel. She will start working in her new office on July 1st. We are also continuing our work toward a future capital campaign. At this time, we are in the preparation phase, which is one of the most important parts of the process. I humbly ask for your prayers as we work to present a thoughtful and professional plan that truly responds to the needs of our parish. There is no rush, because I want to ensure that when the campaign is presented, it is well prepared and worthy of your trust. This may take place next year or even the following year, as we still have many meetings and much work ahead of us. These are just the first steps. In the meantime, we are working diligently on the renovation of our parish offices, which some parishioners have already seen. What has been done so far is only the beginning. One of the most important phases still ahead is the relocation of the main entrance, along with the creation of a waiting room and a worthy break space for our staff. Many who have visited have commented on how beautiful the improvements are becoming. However, so far we have received only one donation from a parishioner for this project. I kindly ask for your support, because without your generosity, it is simply impossible to carry these important projects forward. Thank you and God bless you abundantly!

Ella empezará a trabajar en su nueva oficina el 1 de Julio. También seguimos trabajando en la preparación de una futura campaña de recaudación de fondos. En estos momentos nos encontramos en la fase de preparación, que es una de las partes más importantes del proceso. Les pido humildemente sus oraciones mientras trabajamos para presentar un plan bien pensado y profesional que responda verdaderamente a las necesidades de nuestra parroquia. No hay prisa, porque quiero asegurarme de que, cuando se presente la campaña, esté bien preparada y sea digna de su confianza. Esto podría tener lugar el año que viene o incluso el siguiente, ya que aún nos quedan muchas reuniones y mucho trabajo por delante. Estos son solo los primeros pasos. Mientras tanto, estamos trabajando con diligencia en la renovación de nuestras oficinas parroquiales, que algunos feligreses ya han podido ver. Lo que se ha hecho hasta ahora es solo el comienzo. Una de las fases más importantes que aún nos queda por delante es la reubicación de la puerta principal que da acceso a las oficinas, junto con la creación de una sala de espera y una cómoda zona de descanso para nuestro personal. Muchos de los que nos han visitado han comentado lo bonitas que están quedando las mejoras. Sin embargo, hasta ahora solo hemos recibido una donación de un feligrés para este proyecto. Les pido amablemente su apoyo, porque sin su generosidad es simplemente imposible sacar adelante estos importantes proyectos. ¡Gracias, y qué Dios les bendiga abundantemente!


