A Note from Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings in Jesus Christ!

In the numbers 511 and 512 of the Canon Law of the Catholic Church say,

“Can. 511 In every diocese and to the extent that pastoral circumstances suggest it, a pastoral council is to be constituted which under the authority of the bishop investigates, considers, and proposes practical conclusions about those things which pertain to pastoral works in the diocese.

Can. 512 §1. A pastoral council consists of members of the Christian faithful who are in full communion with the Catholic Church—clerics, members of institutes of consecrated life, and especially laity—who are designated in a manner determined by the diocesan bishop.

§2. The Christian faithful who are designated to a pastoral council are to be selected in such a way that they truly reflect the entire portion of the people of God which constitutes the diocese, with consideration given to the different areas of the diocese, social conditions and professions, and the role which they have in the apostolate whether individually or joined with others.

§3. No one except members of the Christian faithful outstanding in firm faith, good morals, and prudence is to be designated to a pastoral council.”

Following these recommendations of Canon Law and after having participated in the First Session of the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in Rome last October 2023, our Bishop Kevin Rhoades has decided to officially establish the Diocesan Pastoral Council to advise and support him in his Episcopal work. To form this new Council that will represent our entire Diocese, he has carefully chosen some lay people and priests among whom I find myself.

When I received his letter, a couple of months ago, inviting me to be a member of this Council, the first thing I did was to pray to thank God for this great privilege, but at the same time I asked for his grace to carry out with responsibility this new mission that He is placing in my hands. As your Pastor, I am proud to represent you all and to bring to the Bishop's ears the *"Sensus Fidelium"*, the sense God's People.

I ask you earnestly to pray for me to fulfill seriously this new and important service to which God is calling me in my priesthood. I do not want to be more than a simple instrument that God uses for the salvation of souls.

May God bless you abundantly. You all are always in my heart and in my daily prayer.

"All for You Jesus, as Mary did".

Queridos feligreses:

Reciban un saludo en Cristo Jesús.

En los números 511 y 512 del Derecho Canónico de la Iglesia Católica dice:

“511. En la medida en que lo aconsejen las circunstancias pastorales, se constituirá en cada diócesis un consejo pastoral, al que corresponde, bajo la autoridad del Obispo, estudiar y valorar lo que se refiere a las actividades pastorales en la diócesis, y sugerir conclusiones prácticas sobre ellas.

512 § 1. El consejo pastoral se compone de fieles que estén en plena comunión con la Iglesia católica, tanto clérigos y miembros de institutos de vida consagrada como sobre todo laicos, que se designan según el modo determinado por el Obispo diocesano.

§ 2. Los fieles que son designados para el consejo pastoral deben elegirse de modo que a través de ellos quede verdaderamente reflejada la porción del pueblo de Dios que constituye la diócesis, teniendo en cuenta sus distintas regiones, condiciones sociales y profesionales, así como también la parte que tienen en el apostolado, tanto personalmente como asociados con otros.

§ 3. Para el consejo pastoral deben designarse sólo fieles que destaquen por su fe segura, buenas costumbres y prudencia.”

Siguiendo estas recomendaciones del Derecho Canónico y después de haber participado en la Primera sesión de la XVI Asamblea Ordinaria General del Sínodo de los Obispos en Roma el pasado mes de octubre del 2023, nuestro obispo Kevin Rhoades ha decidido establecer oficialmente el Consejo Pastoral Diocesano para aconsejarle y apoyarle en su labor episcopal. Para formar este Nuevo Consejo que representará a toda nuestra Diócesis, él ha elegido cuidadosamente algunos laicos y sacerdotes entre los cuales me encuentro yo.

Cuando recibí su carta hace un par de meses en la cual me invitaba a ser miembro de este Consejo lo primero que hice fue rezar para dar gracias a Dios por este gran privilegio, pero a la vez le pedía su gracia para llevar a cabo con responsabilidad esta nueva misión que Él está poniendo en mis manos. Como párroco de ustedes, es un orgullo representarles y llevar al oído del Obispo el *"Sensus Fidelium"*, el sentir del pueblo de Dios.

Les pido encarecidamente que oren por mí para cumplir con seriedad este nuevo e importante servicio al que Dios me llama en mi sacerdocio. No quiero ser más que un simple instrumento que Dios utilice para la salvación de las almas.

RITE OF SENDING & RITE OF ELECTION

This Sunday we celebrate the Rite of Sending within our parish. It is a celebration that sends catechumens and candidates to the cathedral for the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion. The Rite of Sending was developed to allow members of the local community to experience some aspect of the Rites celebrated with the Bishop. The Rite of Election or enrollment of names is the recognition of God's choice to call the catechumens for immediate initiation into the church. Our elect typically go to the cathedral in Ft. Wayne and the elect are presented to the Bishop. This rite usually coincides with the First Sunday of Lent which begins the immediate preparation for the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.
