SPIRITUAL DROP

XXII Sunday in Ordinary Time – August 30th

Last week, we Franciscan Priests of Mary—who serve as parish priests and community superiors—held our annual meeting in Miami with our Superior General, Fr. Santiago Martín. There, we shared our pastoral experiences and the challenges we face in our parishes, and above all, we reflected on how to pass on the treasure of our charism: gratitude. In light of this gathering, I would like to once again simply express my vision as a pastor. It is neither a novel nor a complicated idea; rather, I hope that together we may live out the vision of the Church: a strong sacramental life, centered on the Eucharist, the source and summit of all Christian life. The parish is not a business filled with bureaucracy, plans, and programs; it is the house of God, where we come to encounter Him, to receive comfort, light, and guidance. For this reason, we need to celebrate the sacraments with reverence, respect, and an awareness of their profound sacredness. Also, as Franciscans of Mary, we want to offer a meaningful and practical message in each homily that helps our faithful journey toward heaven. If we put love for God first, true fraternal life will spring from that love in our community. My greatest desire as your pastor is that we learn together to treat God with the reverence, respect, and dignity He deserves at all times. If we strive to live this out sincerely, the fruits will be abundant: holiness, conversion, service to the poor, and a deeper fraternity among us. God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday!

La semana pasada, los sacerdotes Franciscanos de María que servimos como párrocos y superiores de comunidad tuvimos nuestro encuentro anual en Miami con nuestro superior general, el P. Santiago Martín. Allí compartimos nuestras experiencias pastorales, los retos que vivimos en nuestras parroquias y, sobre todo, reflexionamos sobre cómo transmitir el tesoro de nuestro carisma: el agradecimiento. A la luz de este encuentro, quiero volver a expresar con sencillez cuál es mi visión como pastor. No se trata de una idea novedosa ni complicada; más bien, deseo que juntos vivamos la visión de la Iglesia: una vida sacramental fuerte, centrada en la Eucaristía, fuente y culmen de toda la vida cristiana. Por eso, necesitamos celebrar los sacramentos con reverencia, respeto y conciencia de su profunda sacralidad. También, como Franciscanos de María, queremos ofrecer un mensaje sustancioso y práctico en cada homilía que ayude a nuestros fieles a caminar hacia el cielo. Si ponemos primero el amor a Dios, de ese amor nacerá una verdadera vida fraterna en nuestra comunidad. Mi mayor deseo como párroco es que aprendamos juntos a tratar a Dios con la reverencia, el respeto y la dignidad que merece. Si luchamos por vivir esto con sinceridad, los frutos serán abundantes: santidad, conversión, servicio a los pobres y una fraternidad más profunda entre nosotros. Dios te ama con ternura infinita. ¡Feliz domingo!
