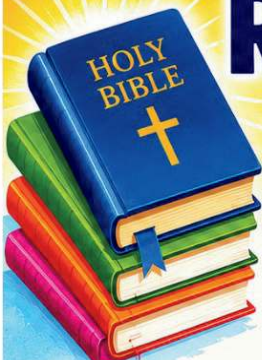

SPIRITUAL DROP

XXIII Sunday in Ordinary Time –September 6th

It brought me great joy to hear Father Raúl preach a few weeks ago about modesty in dress, especially when we come to celebrate the Eucharist. What would you say if one day I approached the altar to celebrate Holy Mass wearing flip-flops, shorts, a T-shirt, and with my hair uncombed? It would surely cause scandal, and many would ask, "How is it possible for that priest to celebrate Mass in such a manner?" Some might even feel deeply disappointed. Yet I would like to remind you that, through Baptism, you too share in the priesthood of Christ and have been made priests, prophets, and kings. I have received the ministerial priesthood; you share in the common priesthood of the people of God. Therefore, just as I must vest with dignity to celebrate Holy Mass as a minister of Jesus Christ, you too are called to present yourselves with dignity as members of a priestly people. God is infinitely greater than any important person in this world. Let us therefore give Him the place He deserves, not only in our hearts, but also in the respectful care of our bodies. Jesus always deserves our very best. I remember that, when I was a seminarian, I once cleaned a table halfheartedly. One of my formators walked by, corrected me firmly, and said, "Clean it well. For Jesus, always the best." Those words remained engraved in my heart. Our bodies are temples and tabernacles of the Holy Spirit; let us care for them and come before the Lord with simplicity, modesty, and reverence—not to judge anyone, but to express outwardly the love we carry within, because He deserves our very best. God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday!

Cuánta alegría me dio escuchar, hace algunas semanas, al padre Raúl predicar sobre la modestia en el vestir, especialmente cuando venimos a celebrar la Eucaristía. ¿Qué dirían ustedes si un día yo subiera al altar para celebrar la Santa Misa con chancletas, pantalones cortos, camiseta y el cabello despeinado? Seguramente sería un escándalo, y muchos se preguntarían: «¿Cómo es posible que ese sacerdote celebre la Misa de esa manera?». Incluso algunos podrían sentirse profundamente decepcionados. Sin embargo, quisiera recordarles que, por el Bautismo, ustedes también participan del sacerdocio de Cristo y han sido constituidos sacerdotes, profetas y reyes. Yo he recibido el sacerdocio ministerial; ustedes, el sacerdocio común del pueblo de Dios. Por eso, así como yo debo revestirme dignamente para celebrar la Santa Misa como ministro de Jesucristo, también ustedes están llamados a presentarse con dignidad como miembros de un pueblo sacerdotal. Dios es infinitamente más grande que cualquier persona importante de este mundo. Démosle, pues, el lugar que merece no solo en nuestro corazón, sino también en el cuidado respetuoso de nuestro cuerpo. Jesús merece siempre lo mejor. Recuerdo que, cuando era seminarista, una vez limpiaba una mesa de mala gana. Uno de mis formadores pasó, me corrigió con firmeza y me dijo: «Limpia bien. Para Jesús, siempre lo mejor». Aquellas palabras quedaron grabadas en mi corazón. Nuestro cuerpo es templo y sagrario del Espíritu Santo; cuidémoslo y presentémonos ante el Señor con sencillez, modestia y reverencia, no para juzgar a nadie, sino para expresar exteriormente el amor que llevamos dentro porque Él se merece lo mejor. Dios te ama con ternura infinita. ¡Feliz domingo!

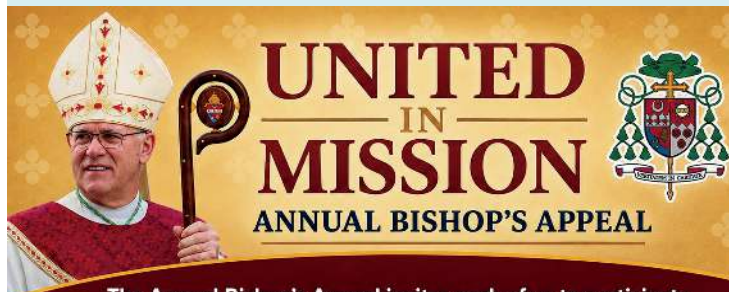
