A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

Today we celebrate two things. First, the importance of praying for the deceased. Many people claim that when we die, we go straight to heaven, but no one can be sure of this because only God knows, and we also know that we are all sinners and need Divine Mercy for the forgiveness of our sins. That is why it is very important to pray for our deceased so that God may have mercy on them and welcome them into His kingdom. Second, we remember that death, although painful, is not the end. Human death reminds us that there is eternal life that Christ won for us on the Cross, and that is the firm hope on which our faith is based and the solid reason for our joy here on earth. Therefore, the reality of death should be a constant reminder to us that we need conversion in order to go to Heaven one day with God and our loved ones. Death is what the spanish writter José Luis Martin Descalzo said:

> Dying is a fleeting bonfire. It is crossing a door adrift and finding what you were looking for.






