A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR **THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED**

Today we celebrate two things. First, the importance of praying for the deceased. Many people claim that when we die, we go straight to heaven, but no one can be sure of this because only God knows, and we also know that we are all sinners and need Divine Mercy for the forgiveness of our sins. That is why it is very important to pray for our deceased so that God may have mercy on them and welcome them into His kingdom. Second, we remember that death, although painful, is not the end. Human death reminds us that there is eternal life that Christ won for us on the Cross, and that is the firm hope on which our faith is based and the solid reason for our joy here on earth. Therefore, the reality of death should be a constant reminder to us that we need conversion in order to go to Heaven one day with God and our loved ones. Death is what the spanish writer José Luis Martin Descalzo said:

Dying is a fleeting bonfire.
It is crossing a door adrift
and finding what you were looking for.

Hoy celebramos esencialmente dos cosas. En segundo lugar, recordamos que la muerte, aunque es dolorosa no es el final. La muerte humana nos recuerda que existe la vida eterna que Cristo ganó para nosotros en la Cruz y esa es la esperanza firme en la cual se cimienta nuestra fe y el motivo solido de nuestra alegría aquí en la tierra. Por eso, la realidad de la muerte debe ser para nosotros un recordatorio constante de que necesitamos conversión para ir un día al Cielo con Dios y con nuestros seres queridos. La muerte aquello que el escrito español José Luis Martin descalzo dijo:

Morir es una hoguera fugitiva.
Es cruzar una puerta a la deriva
y encontrar lo que tanto se buscaba.
