A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR THE SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

With the Solemnity of Christ the King, we bring to a close another liturgical year—specifically Cycle C—and prepare to begin anew with Cycle A. This Sunday presents the perfect opportunity to make a deep examination of conscience, reflecting on our Christian life throughout this cycle as it draws to a close.

May I help you a little with this examination of conscience? For example, we could ask ourselves: How many times did I go to the Sacrament of Confession? How many works of charity have I done? Have I improved my temperament? Am I kinder, more charitable, patient, and merciful, as God is with me? Have I sought professional help to overcome any deeply rooted addictions in my life? Did I attend Mass every Sunday and on holy days of obligation? How much time have I devoted to Eucharistic Adoration? Am I more spiritually holy days of obligation? How much time have I devoted to Eucharistic Adoration? Am I more spiritually disciplined? Do I complain less, and am I more grateful? Am I more involved in the ministries of my parish? Have I prayed for Jesus to send us more vocations? Have I prayed for the sanctification of priests? Have I thanked my priests for their vocation? Have I been generous in Sunday collections according to my means? If I had the opportunity to help my parish or the poor financially, did I do so, or did I keep the money for myself? Have I controlled my tongue to avoid gossip? Have I put God first in all my decisions? Is Christ the only King of my heart, or do I have other little kings who sometimes take Christ's place? Did I seek to establish a deeper relationship with the Virgin Mary? How many times did I pray the Holy Rosary? How many lives of saints have I read, and which one touched my life the most? Did I seek to learn something new about the Catholic Church, its history, its dogma, the Apostolic Tradition, or something about the apologetics? How is my relationship with the Holy Spirit? How many spiritual books did I read? Did I make peace with someone I was fighting with? Did I pray for the souls in purgatory, especially for my family and friends who have already died? If I were to die at this very moment, would my heart be at peace, knowing that I have sought to fulfill God's will in all things? Could I truly echo the words of St. Carlo Acutis: "I am happy to die because I have lived my life without wasting a minute on things that do not please God"?. God loves you with great tenderness. Religious Education Class Schedule






