

September 21st, 2025

St. Gregory the Great, in his Pastoral Rule, explains that when Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you "He meant that the peace he leaves us is the joy that Jesus left us in this world, but that, although it is good, it is fleeting. In that sense, Jesus gives us the peace we need to live in this world. However, when he said," my peace I give to you" He meant that He gives us the eternal peace, which never ends; it is the happiness that awaits us in heaven. In that sense, the joys of this world should not dazzle us, but rather help us aspire to the eternal joys that God has prepared for us in heaven. 


