SPIRITUAL ADOPTION OF AN UNBORN BABY NEXT WEEK!

Everyone loves the beauty and innocence of a baby. As an expression of that love, St. Anthony's will be offering a spiritual adoption opportunity for young and old alike. The members of our parish family will soon have the opportunity to "spiritually adopt" a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all babies make it to birth. Many parents tragically experience the loss of a child to miscarriage or premature birth. And more than 3,000 babies lose their lives to abortion each day. These are the babies you are being asked to "adopt" simply by praying for him or her each day. You may "adopt" a child individually or as a family by signing up during the weekend of January 20th. Prayer pledges will be collected during Mass. 
