A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

The person of Christ is not just to be admired or taken advantage of by only turning to His love when we need to ask for a miracle. The person of Christ is first and foremost to be loved and imitated by us. Above all, Jesus deserves our love for all that He did and continues to do in our lives. Our unconditional love for Him is a token of gratitude for the immense love we have received from Him,

particularly through His blood shed on the Cross, as no one else has died for us in such a way. Furthermore, one of the deepest signs of showing Him our gratitude is by imitating His life, He told us: "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 13:34). This commandment is easy to fulfill when the people we love both receive and reciprocate our affection, as the law of love's reciprocity is then fulfilled. But how difficult and painful it is to love those who do not love us, to love our enemies, to love those we dislike, to love those who are indifferent to us, and even to love those who are supposed to love us. I know it's painful but remember that you have a great opportunity to become more like Jesus, and to be with Him on the cross. Every act of love you offer will not go unrewarded.

God loves you with great tenderness, Happy Sunday!

Nuestro amor incondicional a Él es una muestra de agradecimiento al amor que tanto hemos recibido de Él, sobre todo su sangre derramada en la Cruz porque nadie más ha muerto de esa manera por nosotros. En segundo lugar, una de las muestras más profundas de mostrarle nuestro agradecimiento es imitando su vida, Él nos dijo: "Ámense los unos a los otros como yo les he amado" (Juan 13, 34). Cumplir este mandamiento es muy fácil cuando las personas a quienes amamos reciben y a la vez devuelven con creces el amor que les dimos, entonces se cumple la ley de la reciprocidad en el amor. Pero que difícil y doloroso es amar a quien no te ama, amar a los enemigos, amar a quien no nos cae bien, amar a quien es indiferente con nosotros, amar a quien se supone que nos debería amar.

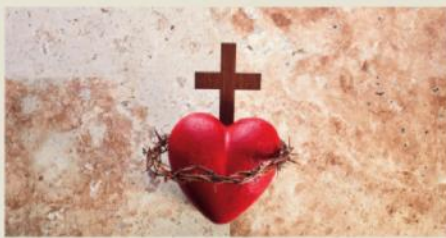


WHAT'S HAPPENING
