A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA IN ROME

There are four major basilicas in the city of Rome: St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, the Basilica of St. Paul's Outside the Walls, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and the Papal Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior and Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran. The last one is also known as St. John Lateran, or, for short, the Lateran Basilica, whose dedication is commemorated today. Although the Pope now resides next to St. Peter's Basilica, St. John Lateran is the official cathedral of Rome. This means St. John Lateran is not only the mother church of the Archdiocese of Rome but also the mother church of the entire world. Its history is rich and fascinating - I encourage you to personally research it on the internet to fully appreciate its significance in our faith.

Today, we also have the privilege of praying for and professing our love for the Pope, who is both the Bishop of Rome and the Vicar of Christ on Earth. Let us recall that St. Catherine of Siena said that the Pope is the sweet Jesus on Earth. It is amazing to know that we belong to the one Church founded by the Lord Himself, and it remains united by the apostolic succession.

Eso significa que San Juan de Letrán no solo es la iglesia madre de la Arquidiócesis de Roma, sino también la iglesia madre de todo el mundo. Les recomiendo encarecidamente que investiguen por su cuenta en Internet para conocer mejor su increíble historia.

Hoy tenemos la gran oportunidad de rezar y profesar nuestro amor por el Papa, que es el obispo de Roma y el vicario de Cristo en la Tierra. Recordemos que santa Catalina de Siena dijo que el Papa es el dulce Jesús en la Tierra. Es increíble saber que pertenecemos a la única iglesia que fundó el Señor y que permanece unida por la sucesión apostólica.

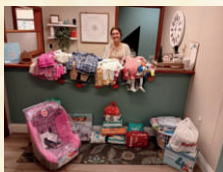
From Youth & Young Adult Ministry:
