A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

XIX SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Parishioners,

Today I would like to express my gratitude for your faith and make a pastoral announcement. One of my goals when I came to San Antonio and San Pablo was to help you become more Eucharistic parishioners so that you would be lovers and defenders of the Eucharist. Three years later, I am delighted to see that many of you have become deeply Eucharistic and very prayerful people. This fills my heart as a pastor because without prayer, our lives are empty and meaningless, as Jesus himself told us, "Without me you can do nothing" (John 15:5). I am deeply grateful to you for being docile to the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Church. I ask you to continue to open your hearts to the Holy Spirit so that He may lead you to holiness, which is the most important project of our Christian life. Motivated by your example of holiness, I have decided to grant the request of several parishioners in Angola to have the Blessing with the Blessed Sacrament in English. As usual, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed after the 8:30 a.m. Mass, and then the priest will give the Benediction in English with the Blessed Sacrament followed by recitation of the Divine Praises. After the Benediction, the Blessed Sacrament will remain exposed all day, as usual, until 6:15 p.m., when the blessing will be given in Spanish. Thank you for your living testimony of faith that enriches my ministry.

Hoy quiero dedicarles unas palabras de agradecimiento por su fe y dar un anuncio pastoral. Uno de mis propósitos cuando vine a San Antonio y a San Pablo era ayudarles a ser feligreses más eucarísticos para que fueran amantes y defensores de la Eucaristía. Tres años después, veo con gran alegría que muchos de ustedes se han convertido en personas profundamente eucarísticas y muy orantes, esto llena mi corazón de Pastor porque sin la oración nuestra vida está vacía y sin sentido ya que el mismo Jesús nos dijo "Sin Mí no podéis hacer nada" (Juan 15,5) Estoy profundamente agradecido con ustedes por ser dóciles a las enseñanzas de Jesucristo y de la Iglesia. Les pido que sigan abriendo su corazón al Espíritu Santo para que Él los lleve a la santidad que es el proyecto más importante de nuestra vida cristiana. Motivado por su ejemplo de santidad he decido acceder a la petición de varios parroquianos en Angola de tener la Bendición con el Santísimo en inglés. Como de costumbre, el Santísimo Sacramento será expuesto después de la Misa de 8:30 am y seguidamente el Sacerdote dará la bendición en inglés con el Santísimo y recitará las alabanzas desagravio.

Después de la Bendición, el Santísimo quedará expuesto todo el día, como de costumbre, hasta la 6:15 pm que se dará la bendición en español. Gracias por su testimonio vivo de fe que enriquece mi ministerio.




