SPIRITUAL DROP

XXI Sunday in Ordinary Time – August 23, 2026

Last week I went to confession, because yes, priests also need to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation frequently. Unfortunately, the priest arrived late to the confessional. There was a long line, so I waited with everyone else. As I waited, however, I noticed several things: some people seemed upset by the delay; others were chatting cheerfully and even making jokes, which led to laughter; others were playing video games on their phones; one woman was fixing her daughter's hair, with a brush and everything she needed, almost as if she were in a beauty salon; others received phone calls and answered them; some were replying to text messages. In the midst of all this, I saw only one young woman who was very focused, praying the rosary with great serenity. She was looking at an image of Jesus nearby and praying with deep devotion.

This made me think about how important it is to prepare ourselves to receive any of the sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Confession, which accompany us on our journey toward eternal life. None of those people was doing anything sinful; they were doing ordinary things but in the wrong place. As Catholic Christians, we are called not only to "be Catholic," but also to "look Catholic": our respect and reverence should reveal what we believe; otherwise, we may give poor witness to our faith. One of the great problems of our time is that we have lost the sense of the sacred. We are so distracted that we struggle to recognize when we are standing before God. Let us never forget that we do not go to church in search of entertainment; we go to encounter the Lord. It is not our house: it is the house of God, which He, in His infinite mercy, opens to all of us. Discretion, respect, and reverence are essential for shaping our spiritual life. God loves you with great tenderness. Happy Sunday!

La semana pasada fui a confesarme, porque sí, también los sacerdotes necesitamos recibir con frecuencia el sacramento de la Reconciliación. Lamentablemente, el sacerdote llegó tarde al confesionario. Había una fila larga, así que me puse a esperar junto con los demás. Sin embargo, mientras esperaba, observé varias cosas: algunos parecían molestos por la demora; otros conversaban animadamente y hasta hacían bromas, provocando risas; otros jugaban videojuegos en sus teléfonos; una señora le estaba peinando el cabello a su hija, con cepillo y todo lo necesario, como si estuviera en un salón de belleza; otros recibían llamadas y las contestaban; algunos respondían mensajes de texto. En medio de todo aquello, vi solamente a una joven muy concentrada, rezando el rosario con serenidad. Contemplaba una imagen de Jesús que estaba cerca y oraba con mucha devoción. Esto me hizo pensar en lo importante que es prepararnos para recibir cualquiera de los sacramentos, especialmente la Eucaristía y la Confesión, que son sacramentos que nos acompañan en nuestro camino hacia la vida eterna. Ninguna de aquellas personas estaba haciendo algo pecaminoso; estaban haciendo cosas ordinarias, pero en el lugar equivocado. Los cristianos católicos estamos llamados no solo a "ser católicos", sino también a "parecerlo": que se note, con respeto y reverencia, aquello en lo que creemos; de lo contrario, podríamos dar un mal testimonio de nuestra fe. Uno de los grandes problemas de nuestra época es que hemos perdido el sentido de lo sagrado. Vivimos tan distraídos que nos cuesta reconocer cuándo estamos ante Dios. Nunca olvidemos que a la Iglesia no vamos a buscar entretenimiento; vamos a encontrarnos con el Señor. No es nuestra casa: es la casa de Dios, que Él, en su infinita misericordia, abre para todos nosotros. La discreción, el respeto y la reverencia son esenciales para moldear nuestra vida espiritual. Dios te ama con ternura infinita. ¡Feliz Domingo!
