SPIRITUAL DROP

Pentecost Sunday - May 24, 2026

One of the main themes of Saint Paul's theology is justification, which means that Christ gave His life for everyone, and through His redemptive death on the cross, He has justified us all. This means that it is by the divine action of Christ and through His redemptive work that we have all been justified from our sins. Although our works are necessary and essential for salvation, it is not our works that save us, but the merciful love of Christ. Thus, we see that Christ loved us all and that His blood shed on the cross was poured out out of love for everyone. He had no preference or favoritism for certain children, nor did He shed His blood as a privilege for only a few, but out of love for the entirety of humanity.

As missionary priests, we are fortunate to carry the message of Jesus to all the peoples where we are sent. Personally, I feel blessed to collaborate with Jesus in His redemptive work. I entered the seminary as a child, and at the age of 19, I began to travel the world, getting to know other cultures. For many years now, I have not lived in my own country; in fact, I have never exercised my priesthood in my homeland. I have always lived as a foreigner... However, as a missionary priest, I have learned that I belong neither to my home country, nor to Spain where I studied theology, nor to the United States where I happily work for Jesus, nor to Mexico, a country I love dearly because of the Virgin of Guadalupe. No, I am neither from here, nor from there, nor from anywhere else. I have learned that I belong to Christ, and to Christ alone. In fact, this is what I usually answer when people ask me where I am from.

This is wonderful to me because I have learned not to have favoritism toward any culture—not even my own, nor the European culture where I lived for many years, nor the Hispanic, nor the North American, because no culture is better than another. All of them have something good, and all of them have something to improve. And just as Christ loved us all on the cross, I ask Jesus that my priesthood may be for everyone, without any favoritism or preferences. I belong to Christ, and I am for everyone.

Jesus, help us to be Yours, and Yours alone, because by being solely Yours, we will be able to love and serve others just as You loved us on the cross. Never forget that God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday.

Uno de los principales temas de la teología de San Pablo es la justificación la cual consiste en que Cristo dio la vida por todos y por su muerte redentora en la cruz nos ha justificado a todos.

Esto significa que es por la acción divina de Cristo y por su obra redentora que todos hemos sido justificados de nuestros pecados, aunque nuestras obras son necesarias e imprescindibles para la salvación, no son nuestras obras las que nos salvan, sino el amor misericordioso de Cristo. Así pues, vemos que Cristo nos ha amado a todos y que su sangre derramada en la cruz ha sido derramada por amor a todos, Él no ha tenido predilección o favoritismos por algunos hijos o no ha derramado su sangre en privilegio solamente de algunos, sino por amor a la humanidad entera.

Nosotros como sacerdotes misioneros somos afortunados de llevar el mensaje de Jesús a todos los pueblos donde se nos manda. Personalmente me siento dichoso de colaborar con Jesús en su obra redentora, desde niño me fui al seminario, a los 19 empecé a viajar por el mundo, conociendo otras culturas, y desde hace muchos años ya no vivo en mi país, de hecho nunca he ejercido mi sacerdocio en mi país. Siempre he vivido como extranjero... sin embargo, como sacerdote misionero, he aprendido que no soy ni de mi país ni de España, donde estudié teología, ni de Estados Unidos, donde trabajo felizmente para Jesús, ni de México país que amo mucho por la Virgen de Guadalupe. No, no soy ni de aquí ni de allá, ni de allí. He aprendido que yo soy de Cristo y solamente de Cristo, además esto es lo que suelo responder cuando me preguntan de donde soy.

Esto para mí es maravilloso porque he aprendido a no tener favoritismos con ninguna cultura ni siquiera con la de mi propio país, ni con la europea, donde viví muchos años ni con la hispana, ni con los norteamericana, porque ninguna cultura es mejor que otra; todas tienen algo bueno y todas tienen algo que mejorar; y como Cristo nos amó en la cruz a todos así le pido a Jesús que mi sacerdocio sea para todos, sin favoritismos ni predilección alguna. Soy de Cristo y soy para todos.

Jesús, ayúdanos a ser tuyos y solamente tuyos porque siendo solamente tuyos podremos amar y servir a los demás como tú nos amaste en la cruz. Nunca olvides que Dios te ama con ternura infinita. Feliz domingo.

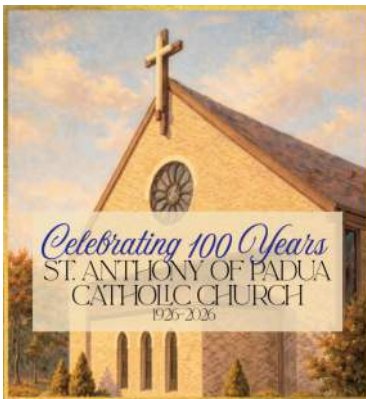
